Youth led organisations are capacitated with skills, build and use evidence-based approaches to advocate for youth-centered and inclusive SRHR and LGBT issues

(Inter)national SRHR advocacy platforms and networks are undertaking concerted and evidence-based advocacy for a progressive SRHR agenda

Amplify voices of young people

Use media and storytelling to inform, address stigma and discrimination, and engage (young) people on SRHR and LGBT rights

Build capacity of youth-led organisations and young advocates to broaden reach and scale impact of SRHR and LGBT advocacy efforts

Create SRHR movements and coalitions, including youth-led organisations and youth advocates at a country, regional, and global level to ensure inclusion and amplify voices of YPs in SRHR policy development, decisions & implementation.

Building and collecting a body of youth-centred evidence - including stories and data - to effectively advocate, engage, mobilise and influence SRHR policy development, decisions, & implementation

- Create (social) media platforms for all YP to express their voices, connect with peers and youth advocates, formulate alternative discourses and claim SRHR and LGBT rights
- Work with progressive mainstream media to produce balanced content around SRHR and LGBT issues
- Increase capacity of youth advocates in collecting and analysing data to effectively use evidence for strategic advocacy efforts
- Build a body of knowledge and use evidence-based advocacy on SRHR of YP to Influence SRHR policy development, decisions and implementation
- Collect and share YPs stories (on SRHR and LGBT) to inspire, engage and activate new advocates and audiences
- Create, engange and mobilise communities on and offline on SRHR, including LGBT rights and issues
- Strenghten rights-based advocacy skills of youth advocates and CSOs at national level
- Strenghten the rights-based advocacy skills of youth advocates and CSOs at global level
