Horizontal: laid back audience

- Youtube
- Waiting room

Vertical: scrolling audience

Walking around with your camera:

- Audience can get 'seasick'
- Hard to edit non-conscious movement
- Like vlogging

Filming from a distance:

- Your film will be boring
- Use shot diversity

The scene is moving, not your camera






































ASSIGNMENT

Filming a displacement of someone Groups of 2
